

Currently, To Graduate from EKU with a Masters in Occupational Therapy students must follow 1 of the following path options:

Option 1: Graduate from EKU Occupational Science undergraduate program; Acceptance to OT Masters Program = 6 years (4 years undergraduate+2 years graduate)

Option 2: Second Degree Option: For students who have a bachelors degree from an accredited higher education institution. Acceptance to OT Masters Program = 7 years (4 years undergraduate+ 1 transition year (also undergraduate)+2 years graduate). **Please note: This is for current academic year 2020-2021. We are transitioning to an Entry-Level Occupational Therapy Doctorate with the first cohort beginning fall 2020.**
